ONLINE NEET/JEE ENTRANCE TRAINING FOR STUDENTS

A number of students who graduate from Indian Schools in Oman pursue courses in Engineering and Medicine in India. They have to achieve higher ranks entrance examinations to get admissions in colleges – Joint Entrance Exam (JEE) for undergraduate Engineering and National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET) for admission in Medical Courses.
