Note:

- Students appearing for the examination must report to the Examination Centre in proper school uniform.
- Admit cards will be issued by the school after the principal's attestation. Students are required to collect them once available.
- Students must carry their admit card to the Examination Centre on all examination days.
- Parents are requested to arrange transportation to and from the Examination Centre.
- Late coming is strictly not permitted. Students arriving late will not be allowed to appear for the examination.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Students appearing for the Exams are expected to follow certain instructions and be aware of the important DO's and DONT's related to the Examination protocols mentioned below.

Students will be subjected to extensive and compulsory physical frisking before entering the Examination Hall.

PERMITTED ITEMS:

- Admit Card, School Identity Card & Residence Card.
- Stationery Items i.e., **Transparent Pouch**, Geometry/Pencil Box, Blue/Royal Blue Ink/Ball pen, Scale, Pencils, Eraser, Analogue Watch, Transparent Water Bottles.

BARRED ITEMS:

- Any Stationery item-such as Textual Material (printed or written), bits of papers, calculator, pen drives, Log Table, electronic pen, scanner, etc.

(Log Table will be provided by School, if needed)



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- Any Communication Devices – such as mobile phones, bluetooth devices, earphones, microphones, pagers, health bands, cameras, digital watches, etc.
- Other items like wallets, goggles, handbags, pouches, etc.,
- Any eatable packs opened or packed, except for Diabetic students, if a Medical Certificate is provided in advance, by the parents.
- Any other items which can be used for unfair means.
- Use of above or similar items will be treated under “**Unfair Means**” category and will attract punishment as per rules.

DRESS CODE:

- SCHOOL UNIFORM with the School id card.
- Those who are suffering from any kind of illness are requested to wear a Disposable Face Mask.

STUDENTS TO KNOW:

- Only blue/ black or royal blue ink/ball point/ gel pen to be used in the answer sheet.
- Check your answer book to see that it is not defective and that it has correct number of pages.
- Write Roll No, other details and Question Paper Code no. in the space specified on the OMR sheet of the Answer Book.
- Check that you have received the correct Question Paper, according to the date sheet, count the no. of pages of the Question Paper and ensure that they are correct. In case any page of the Question Paper is missing, the same should be brought to the notice of the Assistant Superintendent immediately. If you attempt any paper not meant for you, it will be at your own risk;
- Roll no. should **NOT** be written on maps, graph papers etc:
- **DO NOT WRITE YOUR NAME, ROLL NO. OR MAKE ANY DISTINGUISHABLE SIGN OR MARK ANYWHERE IN OR OUTSIDE THE ANSWER-BOOK.**
- Write the supplementary answer book serial No. in the attendance sheet in the specified column.
- Supplementary answer books, maps, graph papers etc., must be securely tied to the main answer book with only white tags/twine which will be provided by the centre.
