### Summer vacation – 2022

1. The last working day before the summer vacation for LKG to XII is Thursday, 9 June 2022.
2. Classes will resume after the summer vacation for:
  - Classes VIII to XII : on Tuesday, 02 August 2022
  - Classes I to VII : on Sunday, 07 August 2022
  - KG : on Sunday, 14 August 2022

### Accolades

3. Hearty **congratulations** to Mrs. Rejani Baiju, kindergarten teacher who received the Navin Asher Kazi Award for Excellence in Teaching-2021-'22 (**BoD's Best teacher Award - second position**).
4. **Academic Excellence Awards** were distributed to the students who obtained 90% and above marks (overall) during the academic year 2021 – 2022.
5. **30 Day-No Screen Challenge** certificates were given to students who successfully completed the 30 day challenge that was held in the academic year 2021 – 2022.

### Activities

6. Students of classes V to XII participated in yoga exercises as part of CBSE-Fit India Fitness activity.
7. Science day was celebrated on 6 June 2022 with a special assembly. Various activities were organised like clay modelling, making birds/ animals with fruits and vegetables, quiz, poster making, working model, Spell bee and ppt-video making on the 'Role of Science and Technology in Sustainable Development'.
8. As part of 'India @75' -Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, students of classes VI, VII and VIII wrote quotes based on the topic: *India's Rich Cultural Heritage*.
9. The **BoD - Samridhi Center for Excellence** in Learning and Teaching which provides online coaching for students preparing for NEET/JEE examinations with three prominent institutions in India – Turito, Career Point and askIITians took an orientation session for the students of classes IX to XII on 8 June 2022.
10. **International Yoga Day** was celebrated on 8 June 2022 in the school. Students demonstrated their Yoga skills during the morning assembly.



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### Summer holiday activities

11. During the vacation, the students should keep themselves engaged in the following ways:

<b>Academics</b>	Students should spend 30 – 60 minutes daily to revise the chapters taught in school so far.
<b>Physical fitness</b>	Students who have been attending regular coaching in the school should continue to do at least 60 – 90 minutes of daily fitness workout at home. While others can do normal exercises to keep fit.
<b>Art, craft, music, etc.</b>	Students should complete an activity in art or craft or learn a piece of music of their liking every week.
<b>Family time</b>	As this is the holiday season, students should spend at least 60 minutes of "Happiness Hour" with the family on a daily basis and also make sure to dine together and/or go on family outings, etc.

### Admission 2022 – 2023 (Current Academic Year)
