Greetings of the day!

Rules and Regulations for Students

This is to reiterate that all students are expected to strictly adhere to the rules and regulations within the school premises. Non-compliance with the same may result in disciplinary action.

The following guidelines must be observed at all times:

- Students must be dressed in the prescribed school uniform or sports attire, as applicable.
- Informal dress is permitted only on a student's birthday or on special occasions authorised by the school. On such occasions, students are expected to dress modestly.
- All shirt buttons, except the collar button, must be properly fastened.
- Clothes and shoes not conforming to the prescribed school pattern or deemed unsuitable will not be permitted.
- Students must report to school in full uniform, with polished shoes and neatly ironed attire.
- Boys must maintain short hair. Sideburns, long hair, mushroom cuts, crew cuts, and facial hair (beard or stubble) are not permitted.
- Girls with long hair must wear two plaits or a single plait. Ponytails are permitted for shorter hair. Hair colouring and leaving hair loose are strictly prohibited.
- Students must keep their nails short. The use of nail polish is strictly prohibited.
- Bringing mobile phones or electronic gadgets to school is strictly prohibited. If a device is brought with prior permission for educational purposes, it must be handed over to the concerned teacher after use.
- Any student found carrying a mobile phone without permission will face strict disciplinary action. The device will be confiscated and returned only to the parent at the end of the academic year.

We seek your cooperation in ensuring that these guidelines are followed diligently to maintain discipline and decorum within the school.
